# MISSION - TASK OR PROCESS?

- ◉ Our tendency is to focus on what we have to do **BUT** ... Mission is firstly a *process / energy / dynamism*
- ◉ Mission is chiefly about who and how we are being asked to be, not about a '*To Do List*'
- ◉ Awareness of being personally called and sent is the primary meaning and nature of mission, because being sent / given is the nature of God's life and love
- ◉ God's Self-Revelation becomes our calling



# MISSION AND MINISTRY

- ◉ With assumption either that everyone is already Christian (*Christendom* model) or that the world is a nasty, threatening place from which believers must be protected (*Sectarian* model), the inevitable tendency is to settle for ***looking after our own*** (*Maintenance* model).
- ◉ When these models of faith-transmission break down, the Church finds itself ill-equipped to share faith with new generations or new groups

- ⦿ A pluralistic, confused society with no consensus about what is the good life
- ⦿ Political and religious institutions in crisis
- ⦿ Needing to find a new language of faith

- ◉ We have Good News to share
- ◉ Christ is Risen
- ◉ He has called us by name through our baptism
- ◉ The Spirit is at work among us and around us
- ◉ God's love and mercy are infinite - and they are entrusted to us

# PRAYER FOR MISSION

- ⊙ *“Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labour in vain” (Ps 127.1)*
- ⊙ Faith is always a response to a divine calling
- ⊙ Faith has the nature of encounter and relationship; not a list of (correct) beliefs
- ⊙ *“I do not call you servants but friends ... I commissioned you to go out and to bear fruit” (Jn 15.15-16)*

# WHAT SORT OF PRAYER?

- ◉ Contemplate the face of Christ
- ◉ Renewed listening to the Word of God
- ◉ *Lectio Divina* and/or other forms of Prayer
- ◉ A training in holiness: “*Christian communities must become genuine ‘schools’ of prayer ... Intense prayer, yes, but it does not distract us from our commitment to ... shaping history according to God’s plan*”
